St. Joseph parish is blessed to have more than 200 wonderful children receiving First Holy Communion this year. To date, we have not had to place a limit on the number of guests who can attend the liturgy at which the children receive Holy Communion for the first time. The church can seat only 850 people. The first communicants will have reserved seats on either side of the main aisle. Please remind family and friends, that, out of courtesy to all, only a few people can reasonably be at Church. Remember your family will receive a DVD of the entire liturgy, which you can share with others at a later date.

We would like to reserve handicap seating. Only two seats will be reserved for each individual requesting this (one for the person needing handicap seating and the second for a person helping them). Please fill out the form below and return it in your child's sacrament packet envelope.
